Darul Quranul Karim began as a community-based organization (C.B.O) established in 2013 in Bungoma, Kenya. Initially registered under the Ministry of Gender, Children, and Social Development, it was founded by Ali Hassan, inspired by his teachers Ismail Otenyo. As the organization grew and welcomed new members, it expanded its outreach activities and came to a deeper understanding of the widespread social challenges affecting communities across Kenya. In response to these evolving needs, Darul Quranul Karim transitioned into a fully registered Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) on July 3, 2025, under the guiding principle: "Poverty Has No Region."

This transformation marked a significant step toward amplifying its impact and reaching underserved communities with greater efficiency and purpose.

 - Early Warning and Conflict Response Systems.








2. Access to Education

 - Farming and Aquaculture Training.






Strategic Objectives

ACHIEVEMENTS

- We are proud of the impact made over the years, including:
- Drilled 25 boreholes in Western Kenya, improving access to clean water.
- Provided psycho-counseling to over 500 inmates across 5 prisons.
- Extended mental health support to 100 patients across 3 hospitals.
 - Facilitated 2 interfaith workshops in Bungoma and 3 in Coastal regions.
 - Distributed over 5,000 food packages to the poor and vulnerable during crises and holy seasons.
